Our first run for 2019 will be to lunch at the historic Coolangatta Estate Winery, Coolangatta, NSW. The estate is the site of the first European settlement on the South Coast of New South Wales. It was in 1822, that partners Alexander Berry and Edward Wollstonecraft settled on the foothills of a mountain named Coolangatta, after obtaining a grant of 10,000 acres and 100 convicts from the NSW Government.

Our route will wind through the back roads of the Southern Highlands before descending through the picturesque rainforests to the dairy farms surrounding Jamberoo. Before reaching Kiama we will ascend Saddleback Mountain, spending a short time at the lookout before continuing on to our destination.
